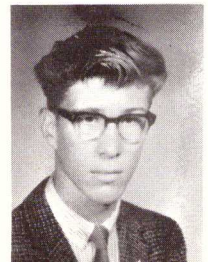
PETER HAAS

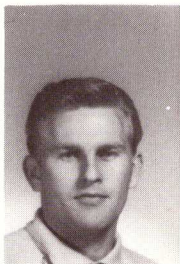






VILENA DUFF
