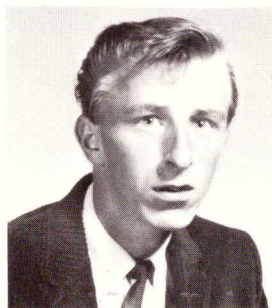
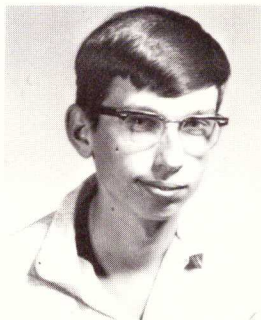


STANLEY GREY

"Inside of school, quiet and demure; outside of school we're not so sure." Roland likes a good joke and inter-mural sports. He plans a future in Forest agriculture.

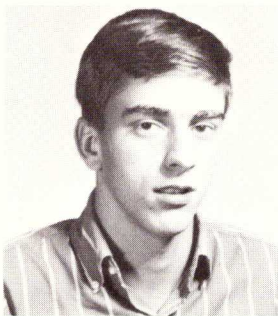


ARTHUR HENNEBURY

JUDY FRASER

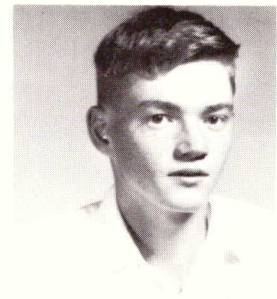
"With malice toward none; with charity for all." She enjoys drama and music and can always be seen carrying a load of books. Judy plans to take a Secretarial Course.

"Better to keep your mouth shut and be thought a fool, than open it and remove all doubt." Gerald likes hockey and plans to be an accountant.

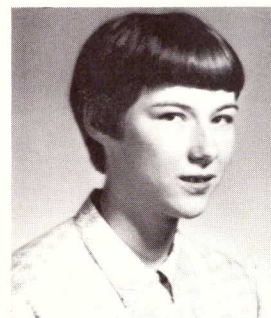


JACQUELINE LANIGAN

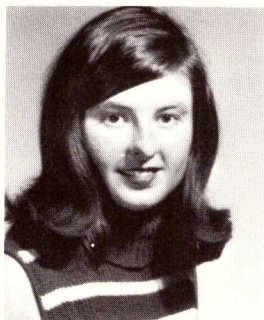
SUSAN HOYT

"A friendly smile of a pleasant sort, a girl with spunk and love of sport." Nancy is good at curling. She plans to be an interior decorator.

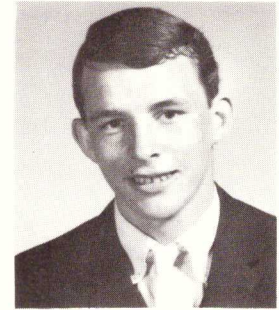


RON MacDONALD

 "Get thee behind me Satan and push." Although he spends most of his time in nonsense, Gordie still manages passing grades. His future is undecided.

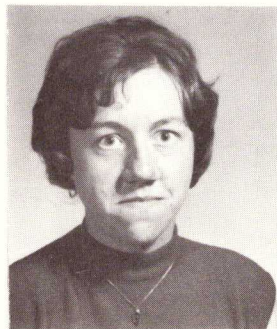
CHARLES DIGOUT

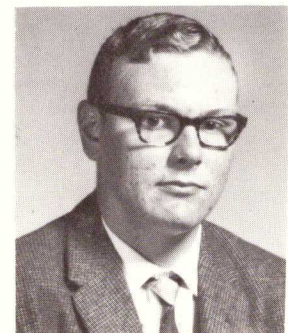
PHYLLIS O'KEEFE

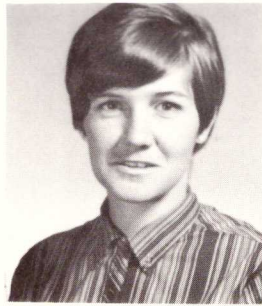
**JUDY

"It's better to be tall and look down, than small and get stepped on." Judy is a cheerleader and likes a SMU student. Next year she plans to attend university.

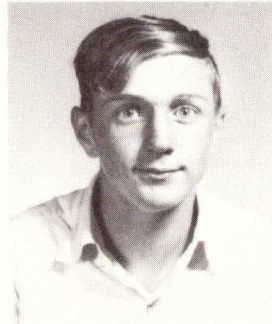
MICHAEL McAULEY

 "Not overly serious, not overly gay, but a nice girl in her own way." Pam is a pleasant girl who plans to be a medical secretary.

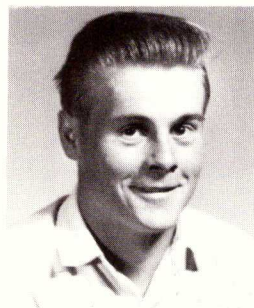


MADONNA MARRYATT

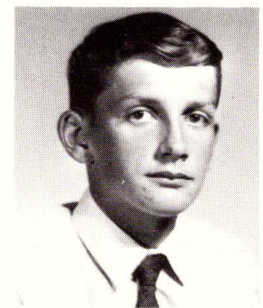


ROBERT HATCHER

 "To observe is to know." Leo is one of the silent one we do not know much about. He is active in soccer, basketball and hockey. Leo plans to attend Saint Mary's.





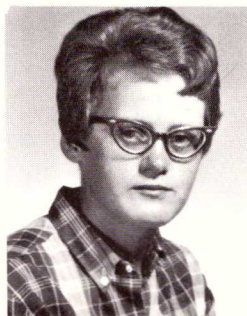
ANDREW MacLEAN

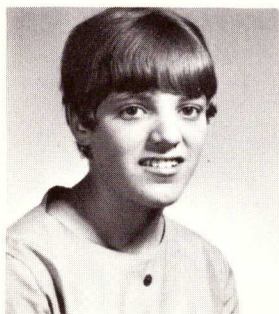
PEGGY MARTIN

 "Laugh and be merry you're dead a long time." When she's around there's never a dull moment. We're sure she will be a credit to the teaching profession.



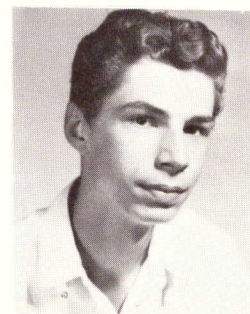
DOREEN SAULIER

 "Genius and insanity go hand in hand." 'Eddie the friendly giant' enjoys all sports and plans to take a Chartered Accountant Course.

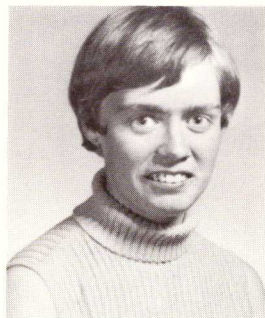


TERRI GARRIGAN
 "Live, laugh and be merry." She loves to talk and indulge in mischief. Her activities include dancing, boys and more boys. Plans to take Commercial at Vocational.



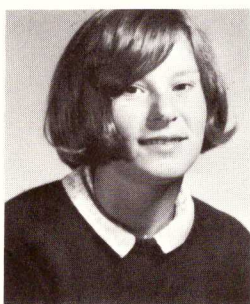
LEO WARREN

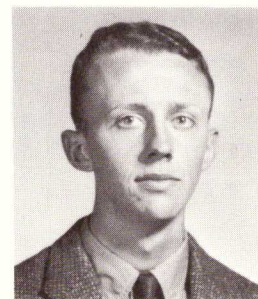
**STAVROULA

 "God gave me the gift of speech and I always put gifts to their best use." She is always ready to pitch in any activity. Plans to attend N. S. I. T.

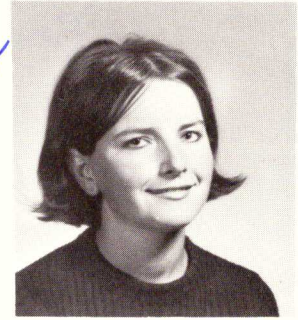
GEORGE GAGNE
 "Then he will talk, ye gods, how he will talk!" George spends most of his time eating and teasing. His future is undecided.





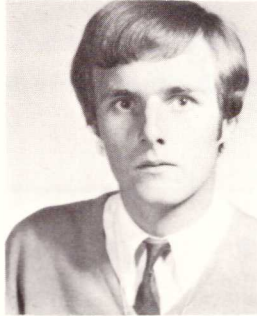
LINDA MARTIN
