Marilyn Drysdale

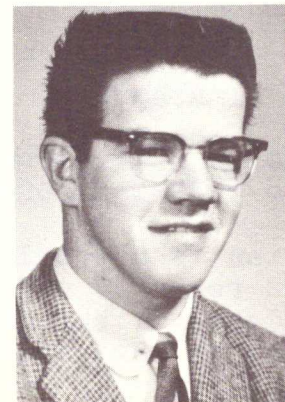
" Where there's a will there's a way "

Bernice Marryatt

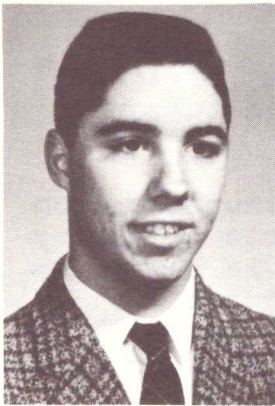
"She is a quiet Miss, we know not much about her."

"It is better to keep your mouth closed and be thought of as a fool; then to open it and remove all doubts."

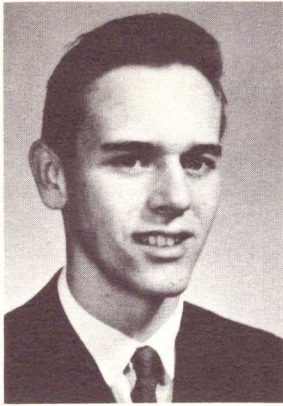

Terry Walters

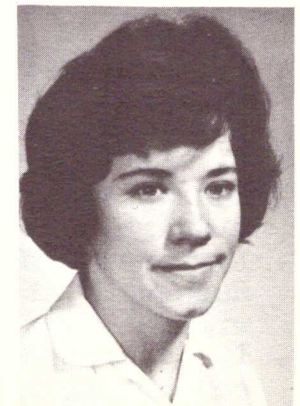
"Sports I like, I really do, but studies are matters for others to do."
