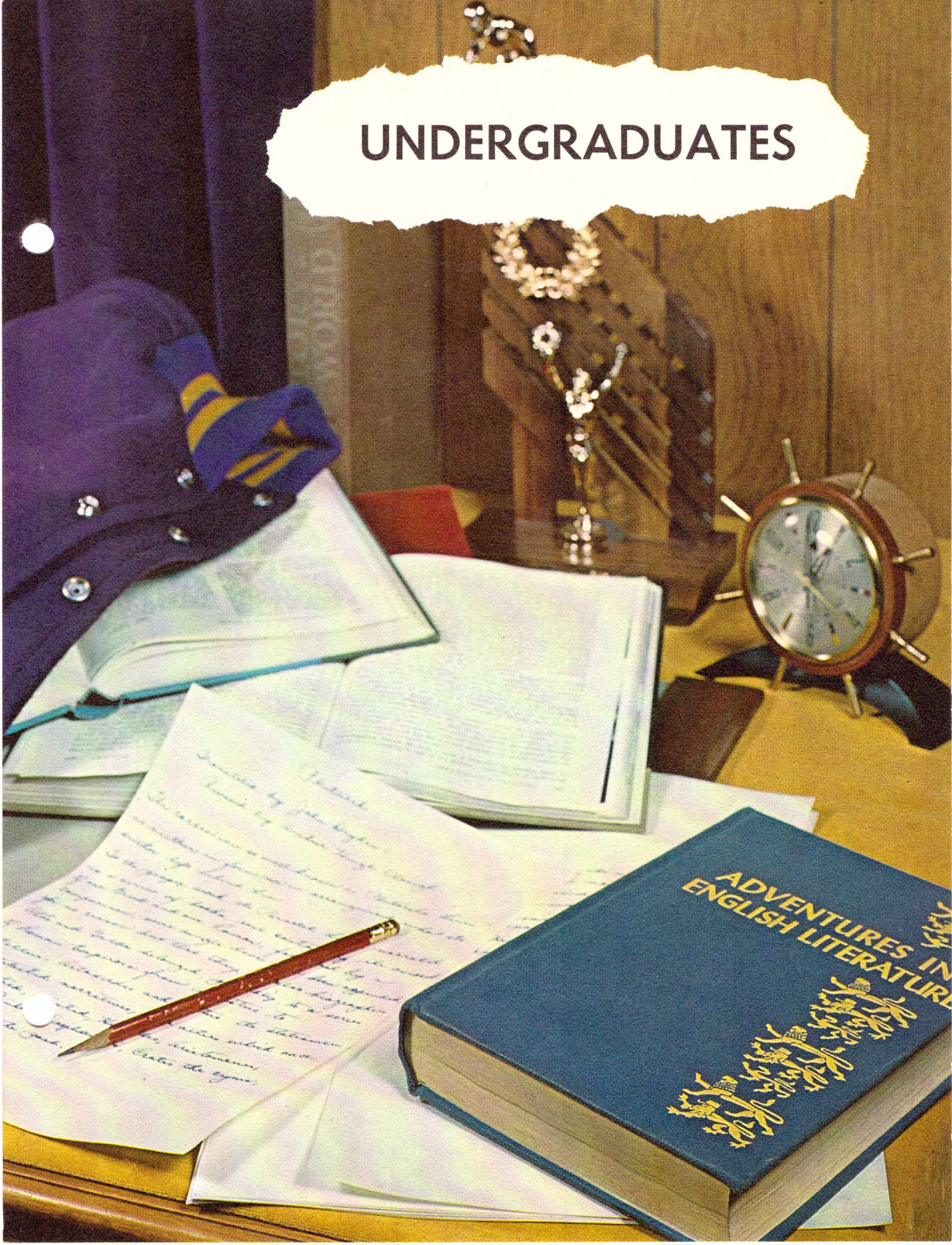

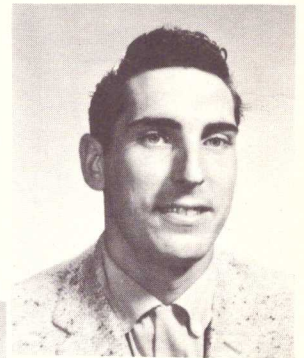


Burglind Blei

Graham appears to be an angel in class (chuckle! chuckle!) but a wizard on ice. Hockey is his delight.



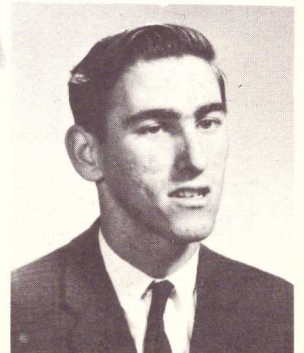
Neal Bowers

Our Red Cross vice-president and a member of the U.N. Club is the witty nut of the class. Neal can play a joke or take one, all in fun.



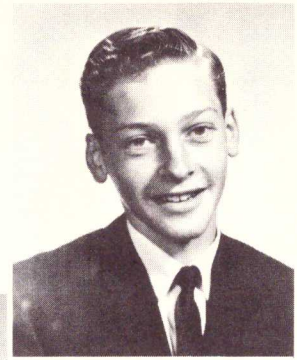
Tom Brennan

David, who is always ready for good clean fun, has a heavy responsibility on his shoulders as he is the president of the B.C. Silver Junior Red Cross.



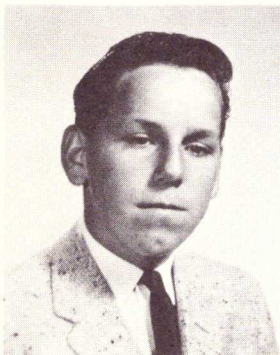
Shirely Grey

Because of her contagious laugh, Willa is liked by everyone. She is a member of the U.N. Club, Glee Club, and handles make-up in the Drama Club.



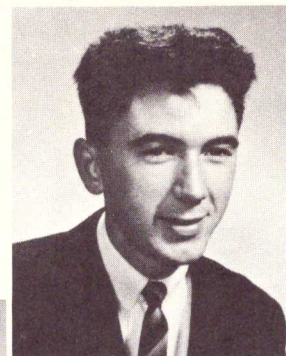
Carolyn Mont

Last but not least comes Wolfgang, who nobody can help but like because of his kindness towards everyone. Besides being studious, Wolfgang is also very good at telling jokes.



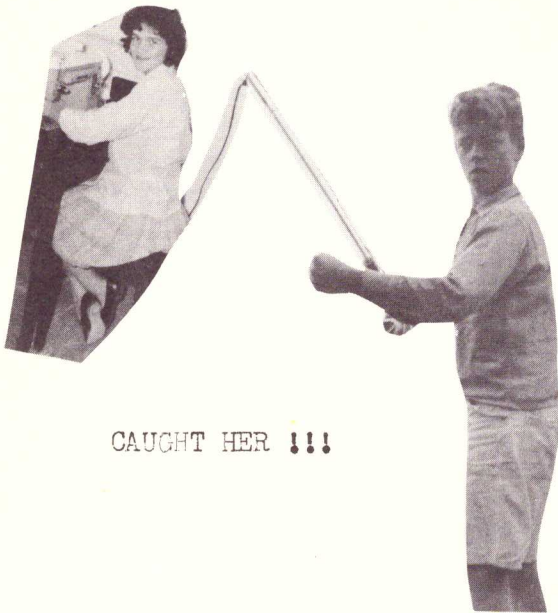

And it did end.

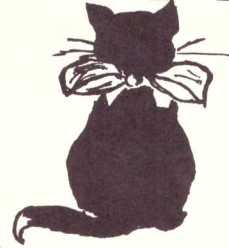

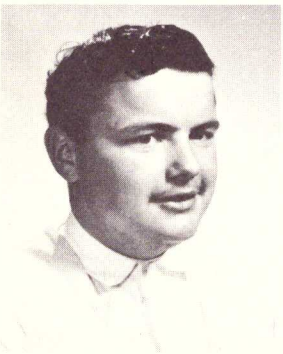
Judy Beazley

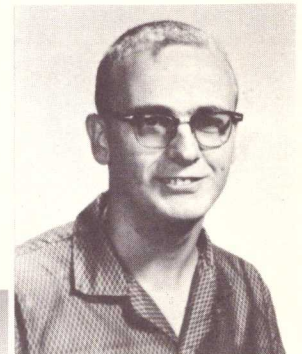


Herb Gaberau

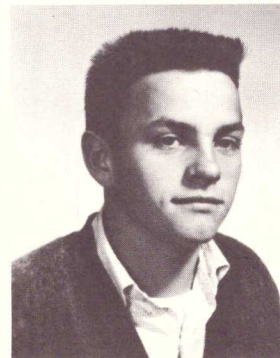
Eric Hayden

David, the Mario Lanzo of our class is constantly being reminded of his overdue assignments. David's plans are to become a teacher and we're sure he'll succeed.



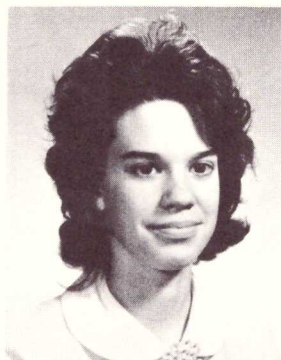
Gail Jardine

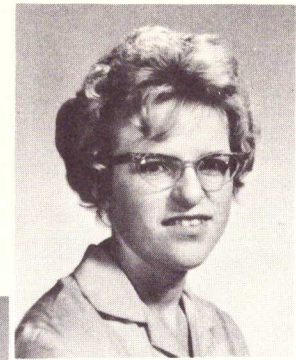
David Walker

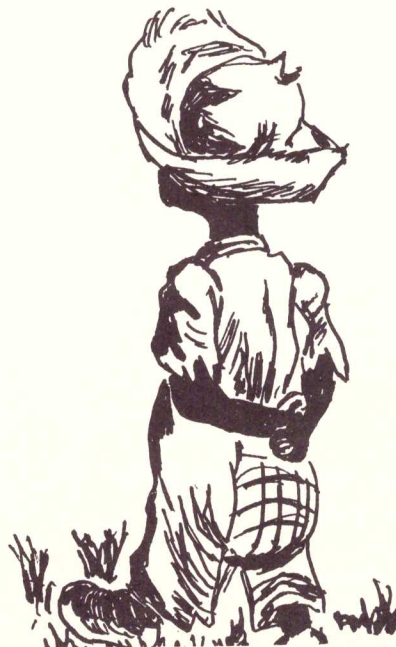
Ronald Whitehead

Patsy is usually found talking to a certain member of our class. She too, is going to enter Vocational.



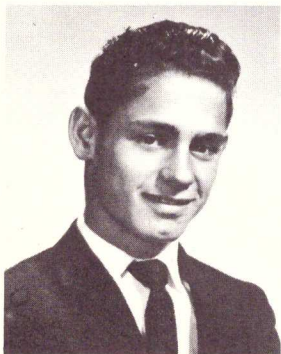
Gerry McIntyre

Mike, one of our many fun-loving inmates is always ready to join in any shenanigans. His main aim is to get his Grade 11. All our luck goes with him.

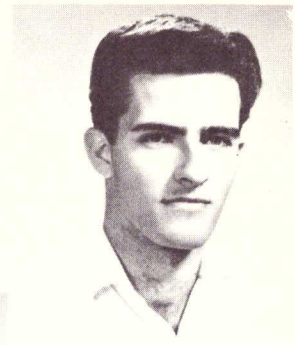


Norman Mitchell

Sylvia can usually be found worrying if she studied enough or not. She plans to attend Vocational next year. Good Luck, Syliva



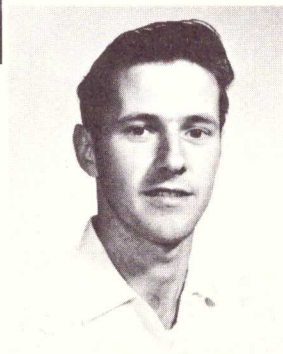
Dennis Touesnard

Ron Trueman

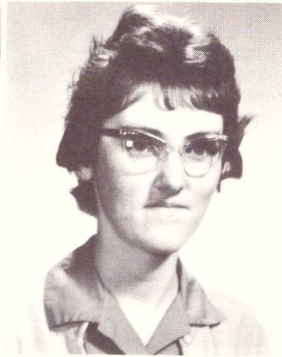
Ron, the easy-going nomad of our class can usually be found wandering into the library in the middle of a class. Ron plans to enter trade school next year. Good Luck, Ron.
