

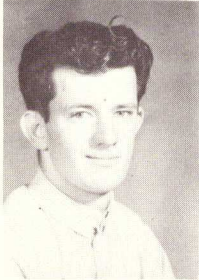

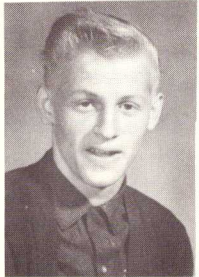
Jim Bradbury—

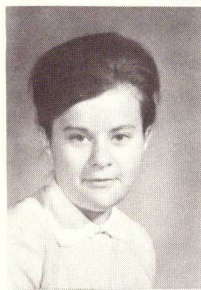
Bonita Feltham—

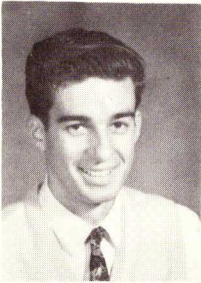
Evelyn Just—

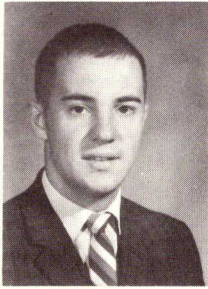
Frances McBride—

Being one of the shorter pupils does not stop Gary from keeping up with the rest of the class. Gary wants to become a chartered accountant, in the near future.



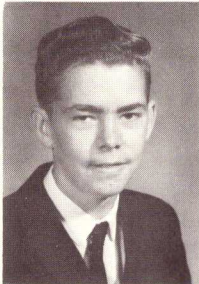
Sheila Russell—

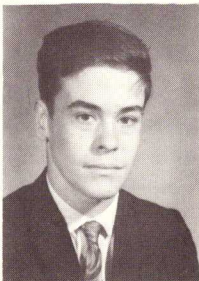
Douglas Scoville—

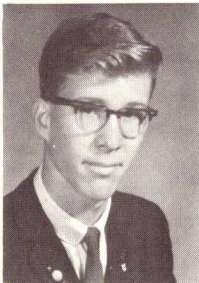
Michael Smith—

Mike delights in his own humor, but manages to make Linda laugh. He enjoys witty expressions and a good science fiction book. A medical career is his ambition.



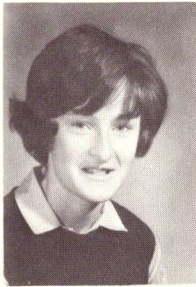
Stephen Strople—

Bobby is a very quiet and serious student. After completing his Grade XII, he plans to attend King's for a degree in Theology. We wish him the best of luck in the future.



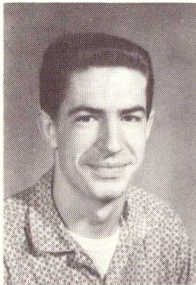
Shirley Walsh—

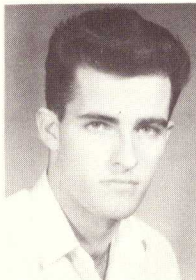
Susan Brodsky—

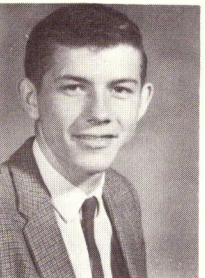
Richard Croft

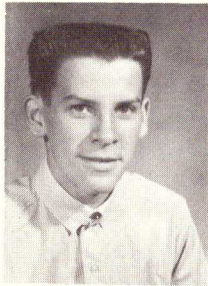
Karl an active member of our class is on the class soccer team. His plans include entering trade school next year. Good luck, Karl.

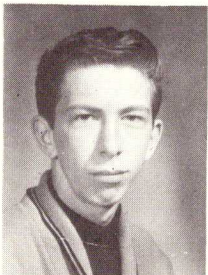

Barry, an ardent guitar enthusiast, shows his skill in our school bank. After completing Grade XII, Barry wishes to become a commercial artist. All the best Barry.



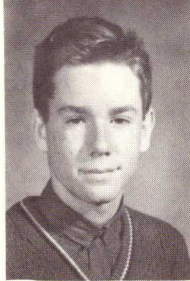
Sharon Hamm

Sharon is one of the quiet and studious members of our class. She plans to enter the field of nursing. Good luck in your career, Sharon.



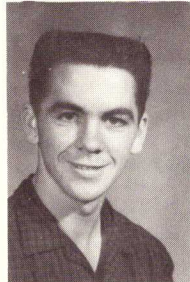
Judy McGrath

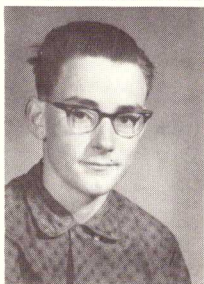
Heather Richardson

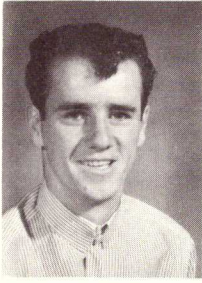
Lynda Russell

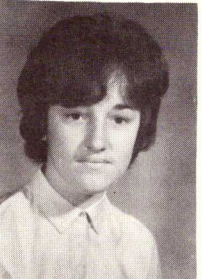
Pamela Stewart

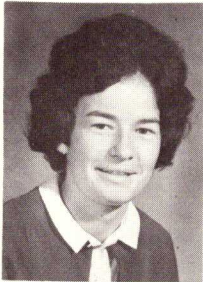
Gerard Veldhoven

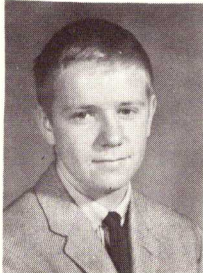
Donna Walters

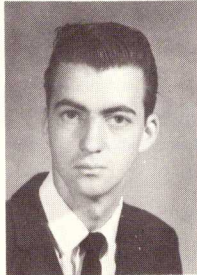
Lee Burke

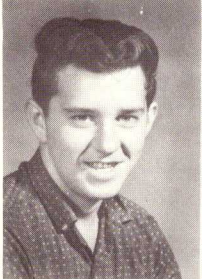


Linda Corbin

Linda, one of the cheerful members of 11 H, is an avid member of our cheerleaders. She hopes to enter the armed forces in the near future.



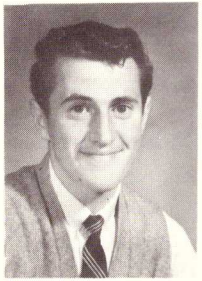

Larry is the carefree type. His plans for the future are unknown, but the best wishes of the 11 H class go with him in whatever he decides to do.



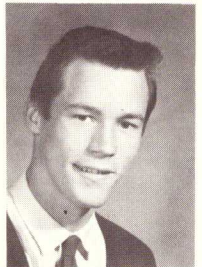

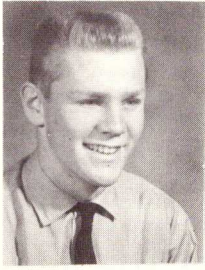

Richard is the tall, dark and silent type. Though his future plans are unknown to us, we know that Richard will succeed in whatever he attempts.





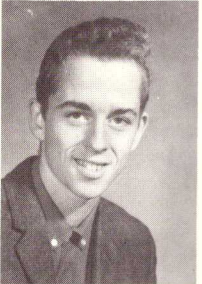
Diane MacAdams

Diane is a popular member of the class who doesn't say much, but when she does, says it well. She plans to be a lab technician.



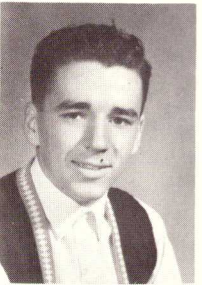
Marie MacIntyre
