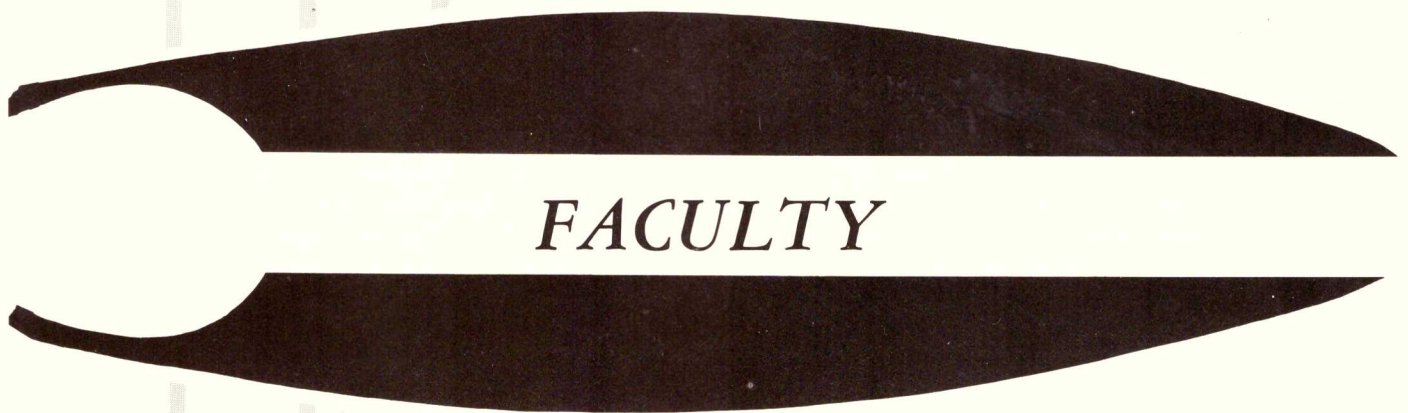
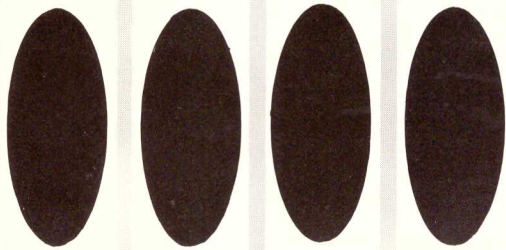
While at St. Francis Xavier he became president of the Canadian Federation of Catholic Students and was chosen as a delegate to attend a conference in Europe.

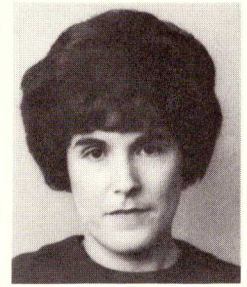

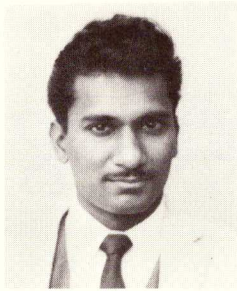
