This year's school activities commenced with the election of Students' Council class representatives, followed shortly by the election of the executive.

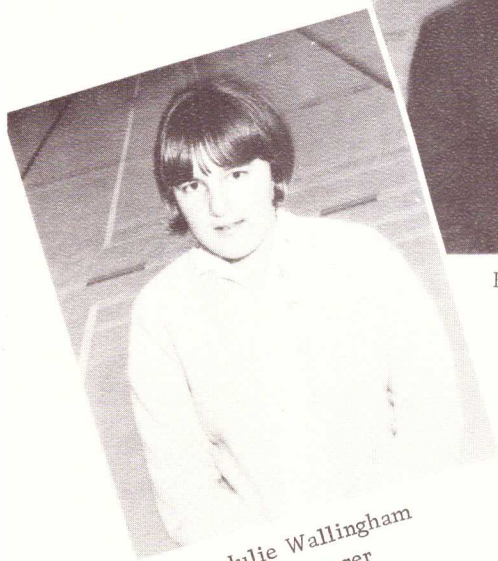
This year a new fund raising project was inaugurated, this being the sale of school chocolate bars. Under the excellent direction of Doug Engram this project recognized a profit of over \$500.

I also wish to thank Mr. Currie, the Faculty, and the Student body for supporting me in school endeavours in making this year the rich and rewarding experience it was.



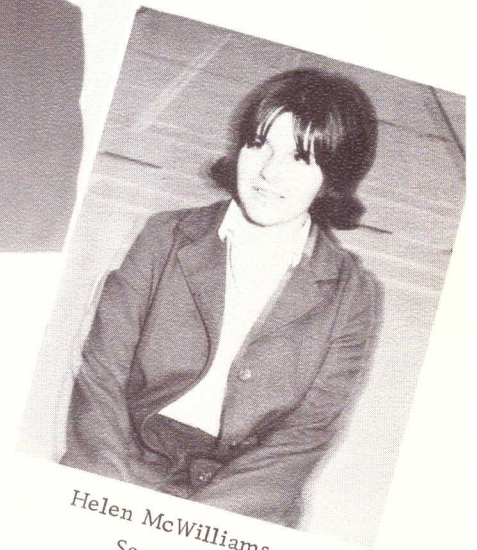

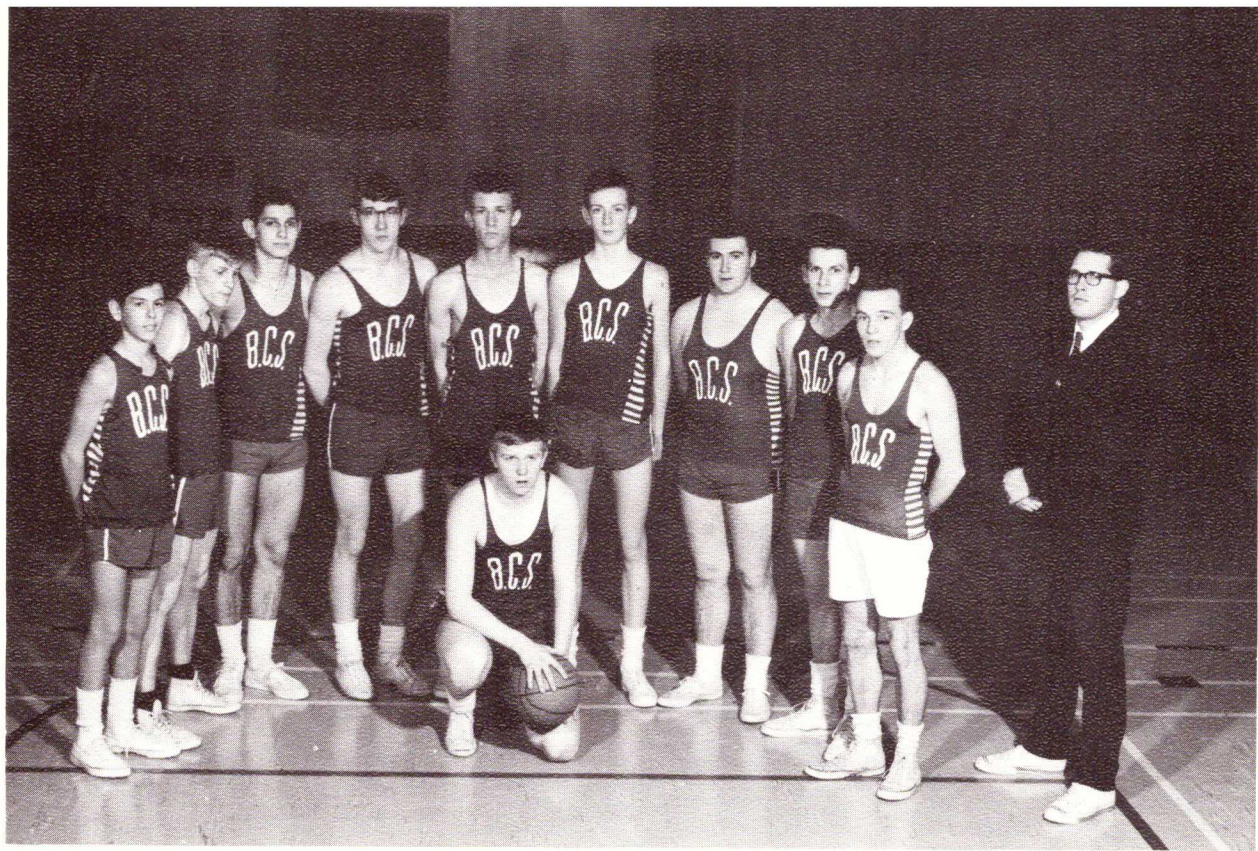
Next year is to be looked forward to with great anticipation, and we feel confident that a winning team can be placed in the field.

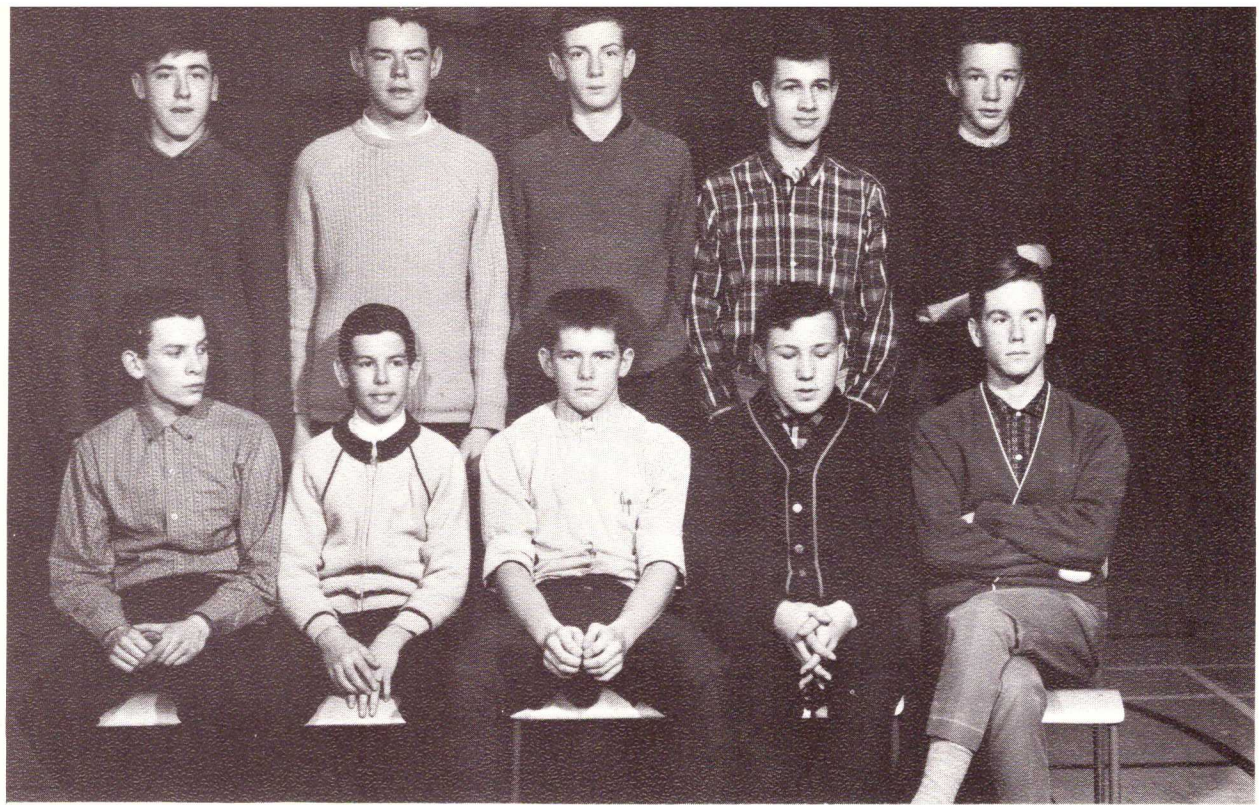

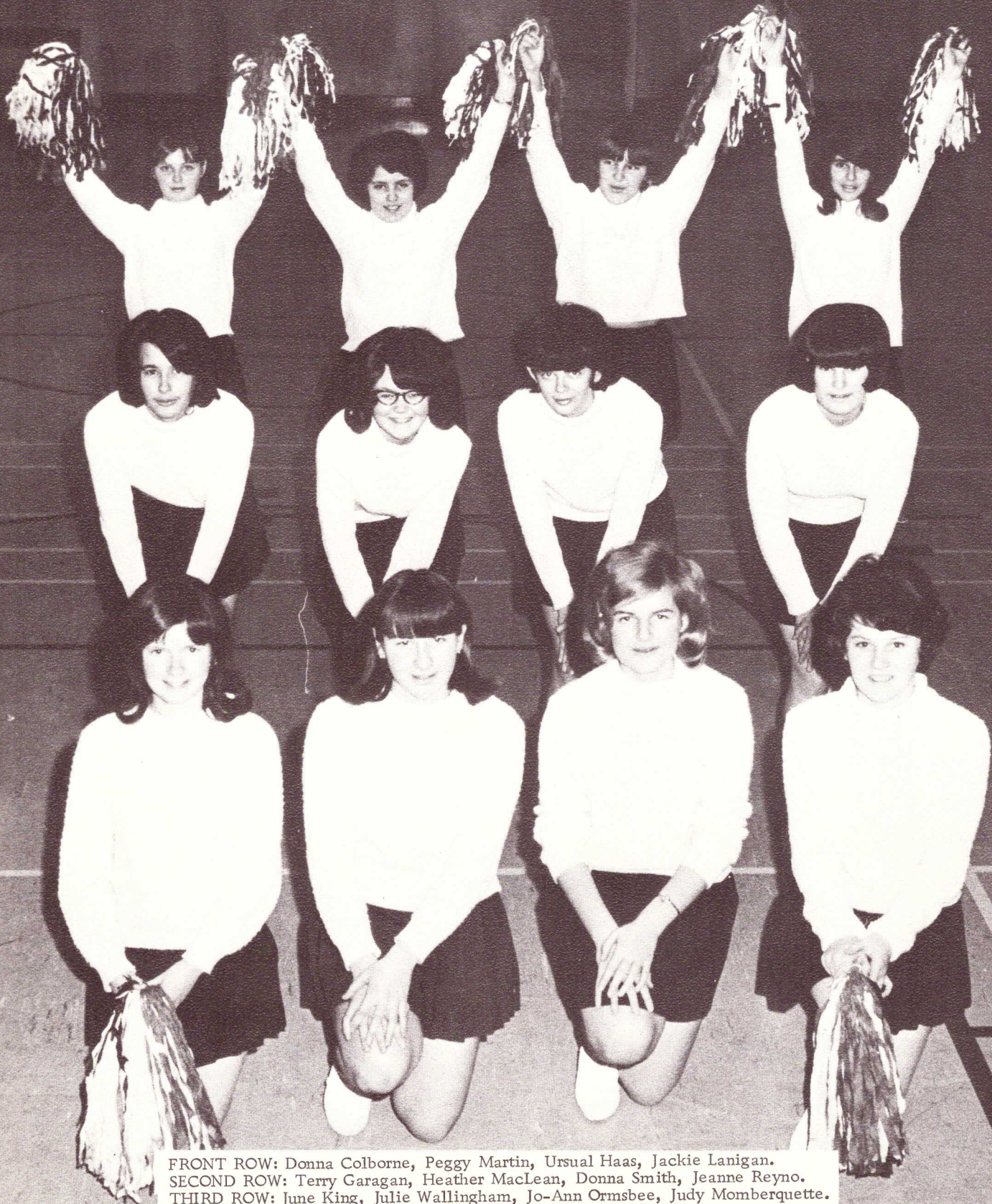
